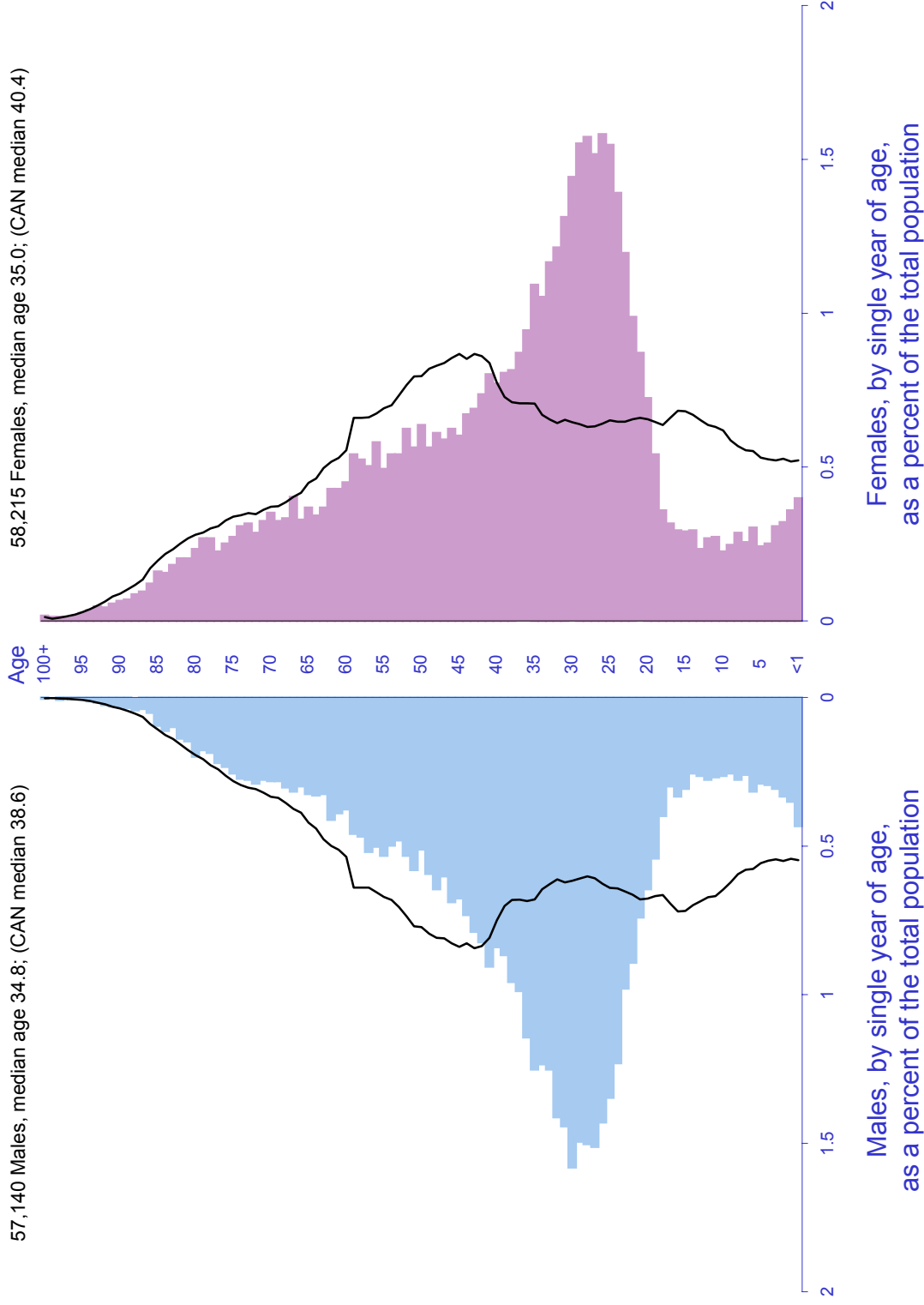

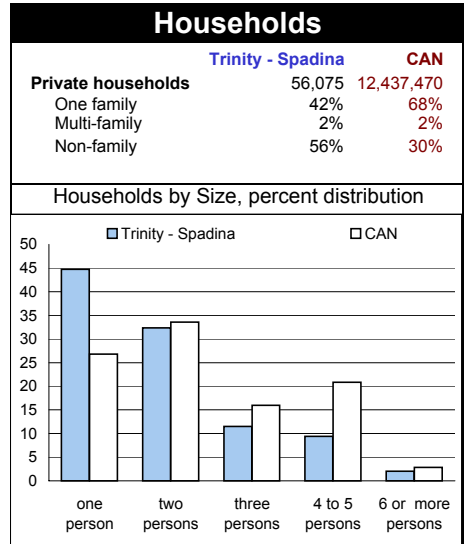
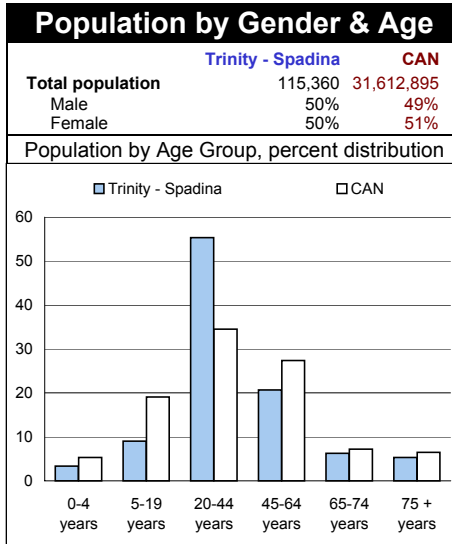

Age pyramid of Trinity - Spadina, FED compared to Canada (line)



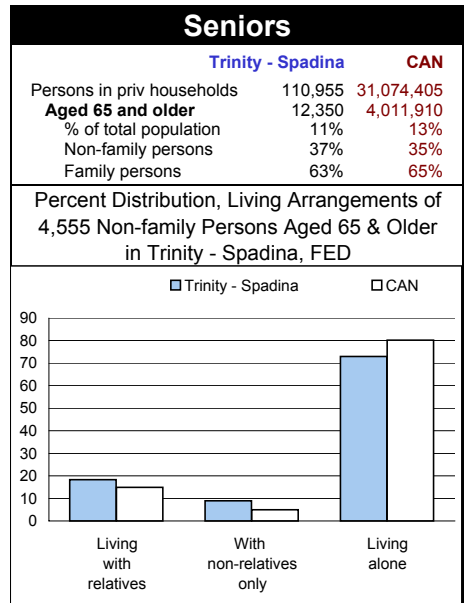
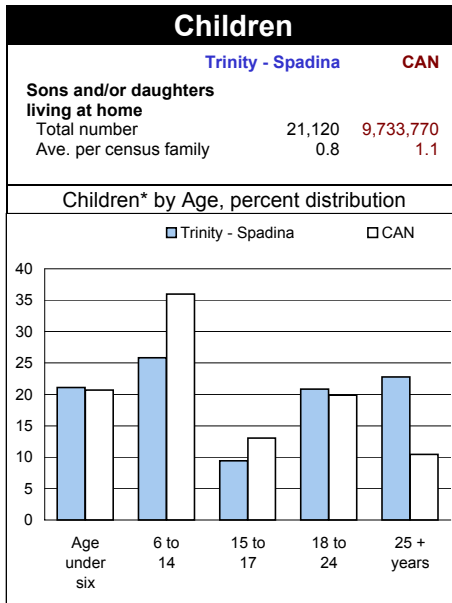
